This six session programme is for both experienced and new subject/team/middle leaders in primary schools who are looking to further develop their leadership and management skills. The programme will support the drive for improvement in your own school, and successfully develop your leadership skills and confidence. As part of the programme participants will develop a school based leadership project to focus and apply their learning. This will relate to areas for development from their own school development plan.

During the programme you will:

- ✓ explore the characteristics of successful leaders and leadership
- ✓ explore the accountability role of the subject/team/middle leader in school improvement
- ✓ review, and explore the further development of, your personal and interpersonal leadership skills
- ✓ consider how to lead others supporting and challenging individuals and teams
- ✓ develop strategies for courageous conversations
- lead a change in your school, developing a school based and practical leadership project

Nigel was previously Senior Adviser for Cambridgeshire LA for seven years and has worked at The Eastern Leadership Centre, leading the organisation and delivery of senior leadership programmes, including NPQH. He was also an accredited national trainer for the Training and Development Agency, facilitating training nationally for a number of TDA programmes. He is a lead facilitator for ELC. As a partner in 'Partnerships for School Improvement', he also works as a School Improvement Adviser to schools. Nigel has been headteacher at two schools. Ofsted noted Nigel's "inspirational leadership".
